ARTICLE XIII Amendments to the ASCC Constitution

<u>Section 4</u>. Ten school-day notice will be given to all amendments and revisions before they can be voted upon by the electorate. All amendments and revisions will be available to the student body at least 10 school days prior to an election.

ARTICLE XIV By-laws Amendments to the ASCC Governing Documents

<u>Section 1</u>. By-laws to this constitution shall <u>Amendments to ASCC governing</u> documents must be passed approved by a 2/3 vote of the Executive Board.

Section 2. By-laws to this constitution shall <u>Amendments to ASCC governing</u> documents must be voted upon within four weeks of the first day of classes of the spring semester of each school year. If new by-laws-amendments are not approved within the first four weeks, the prior year's by-governing-laws shall automatically be in effect. After the four weeks the by-laws may be revised if voted to do so by a 2/3 vote of the Executive Board. By-laws and codes are synonymous.
